How we got here

- Charities Act 2009
- > Process started in 2014 by Scouting Ireland
- > Numerous levels of Consultation
- > NMC decide to go Company only structure
- > Structural proposals at local and national level voted on at National Councils, with final decision at EGM on 6th October 2018
- > Part of the proposal is that each Scout Group would register as it's own Charity entity





Duties of the Trustees

- > Comply with the governing document
- > Carrying out its charitable purpose through scouting
- > Act in the best interest of the Group and with reasonable care and skill
- > Manage the assets of the Group
- > Keep proper books of account and submit an annual report and accounts to the Charities Regulator
- > Some additional duties outlined in their guidance document

Registration with the Regulator

- > Follow the "Pack" document in the mailing on the 11th November
- > Group Council meet and puts in place a number of policies for the benefit of the Group and the registration process
- > All additional info and documents are gathered together
- > Registration done through the Regulator's portal
- > Charities Regulator may request additional documents or clarification information
- Group receives a RCN (Registered Charity Number)
