## Do

Inspired by the film, you must recreate a short scene (under 30 seconds) from a famous film using whatever you can find. This does not have to be a fancy or professional video, just a simple, yet fun, one which reproduces a short part of a famous film. In choosing and making your Sweded versions of a famous scene, it might be helpful to try and replicate clips found online, such as Jurassic Park (<a href="http://youtu.be/PJlmYh27MHg">http://youtu.be/PJlmYh27MHg</a>) or The Avengers (<a href="http://youtu.be/QIQ\_thbFtDA">http://youtu.be/QIQ\_thbFtDA</a>). These do not have to be complication or technically brilliant, they are meant to be fun! While everyone in the patrol may not be performing in the scene, everyone will have a role doing things like filming or getting customs together.
